CALL FOR LATE BREAKING ABSTRACTS

AIMM has sponsored very successful open sessions at its annual meeting. This has provided attendees with a chance to present their most recent data 'off the bench' and "from the clinic" (case reports also welcome). You are invited to submit an abstract of the scientific research you would like to present during two open sessions at the upcoming meeting. Basic, clinical, or translational research in any area of bone biology or clinical bone disease is appropriate for presentation.

Our aim is to achieve a balance between basic and clinical talks. Speakers will be allocated 10 minutes to present and then another 5 minutes for discussion/questions.

To facilitate program planning, suitable abstracts are now being accepted on a first come, first-served basis. Abstracts can be up to 2500 characters, including spaces and figures.

Authors will be notified as soon as their abstracts are accepted. Currently, the clinical talks are slated for the Thursday afternoon session and the basic/translational talks will be on Friday afternoon.
