

**Advances in Mineral Metabolism AIMM/ASBMR
John Haddad Young Investigators Meeting
April 7 - 10, 2026**

The Advances in Mineral Metabolism AIMM/ASBMR John Haddad Young Investigators Meeting is moving to a four-day format in 2026. The conference begins on Tuesday morning, April 7, 2026 and concludes in the early evening on Friday, April 10. Once again, the meeting will be held at the Stonebridge Inn, which is located slope-side in Snowmass Village, a small and family-friendly Colorado mountain town located just 9 miles from Aspen. Past AIMM participants rave about the relaxed environment and stimulating scientific/clinical discussions ... and they keep coming back year after year!

The goal of this conference is to discuss important or evolving concepts in bone biology and clinical bone disease in a small and informal group setting. The atmosphere is enhanced by the midday break from 9:45am - 3:00pm, at which time Meet-the-Professors, debates, panel discussions, or mentoring sessions can occur. Attendees can also use the midday break to enjoy a variety of activities available in the Aspen/Snowmass area including downhill and cross-country skiing, snowboarding, snowshoeing, hiking, tennis, sightseeing, and relaxing in the beauty of the Rocky Mountains. This unique format enhances opportunities for young and more-established investigators to discuss ideas, develop new networks, and engage in mentoring while having fun. We encourage registrants to bring their family members to enjoy the local recreational offerings and to participate in several AIMM activities.

Meeting Location

All AIMM events will take place in the conference area on the main floor at **The Stonebridge Inn**, located at 300 Carriage Way, Snowmass Village, CO, 81615.

Meeting Registration

The meeting registration fee (\$450) includes the 4-day conference, Welcome Reception, Awards Dinner, and 4 breakfast vouchers. Guest registration fee (\$100) admits your guest(s) to the Awards Dinner and participation in AIMM's own private NASTAR ski race. The venue can accommodate up to 80 meeting attendees and therefore registration will close once that number has been reached.

Ski Lift Tickets and Discounted Equipment Rentals & Lessons

AIMM attendees and their guests can purchase discounted lift tickets in advance of the conference. Ski passes can be purchased as single or multi-day passes. A lift tickets is accepted at all 4 of the Aspen Snowmass mountains (Aspen, Snowmass, Aspen Highlands, and Buttermilk). Discounted equipment rentals and lessons are also available to AIMM attendees (refer to the flyers that follow the lift ticket form)

Meeting Hotel

AIMM has reserved a block of hotel rooms at **The Stonebridge Inn** for a negotiated rate of **\$199/night** (single or double occupancy). A \$25/night surcharge for each additional person in the room over 12 years of age, children under the age of 12 stay free in their parent's room. Listed rates for all accommodations do not include a taxable 6% Resort Fee and 12.8% Tax. **It is best to secure lodging reservations ASAP due to high demand for rooms during primetime spring skiing.**

Transportation

Snowmass Village is serviced by three airports: Denver International airport (4-hour drive), Vail/Eagle airport (2-hour drive), and Aspen/Pitkin County airport (10-minute complimentary shuttle to Snowmass). Within Snowmass Village, a complimentary shuttle runs continuously to most local locations in the village and to Aspen.
